The National Safe Tractor and Machinery Operation Program (NSTMOP) is a project of Hazardous Occupations Safety Training in Agriculture (HOSTA) for youth ages 14 and 15.

- This training addresses the federal Hazardous Occupation Orders in Agriculture (HOOA).
- Content covers general farm safety as well as tractor and machinery.
- To receive certification youth must pass a written test as well as operational testing.
- Certification requires at least 24 hours of study with additional supplemental practice.
- ◆ Parental participation is expected.
- Mentor/Coach/ Parent assistance is needed for the home study and practice.
- All ages (8 adult) welcome to participate. Only those ages 14 and over can become certified.
